The marriage license was issued on January 27, 1892 by W. A. Leigh, Walker County Clerk. The marriage was performed and certified by C. R. Guerrant on January 28, 1892. The marriage record was then filed in Walker County on February 4, 1892.

The actual place of the marriage ceremony is uncertain, but it probably occurred in the Cotton community at the home of Alice Williamson's parents.
